## ATANCE



### ATANCE Cuveé N°1 2024 || 92 points

“The white 2024 Atance Cuveé N°1 was produced with 55% Merseguera, 25% Macabeo and 20% Malvasía. It fermented in stainless steel, matured with lees and was bottled unoaked. After the experience with 2022, they harvested even earlier. It’s balsamic and mineral, clean, fresh and subtle, with some herbal notes, hints of white flowers and fruit. It has a vibrant palate with pungent flavors, intensity and balance.”



### ATANCE Bobal 2024 || 92 points

“The 2024 Atance Tinto was produced with Bobal grapes from the Casa Segura property in Venta del Moro. It fermented in stainless steel and matured in 8,000-liter oak vats for four months and then went into stainless steel until bottling. It’s floral and perfumed, high-pitched, attractive and clean, with a medium-bodied palate, very good freshness and balance and very fine tannins.
