## BODEGAS RODA



### SELA 2023 || 91 points

“Lots of fruit here, a little baked, showing cherry compote, red plums and a touch of raspberry jam. Juicy on the palate with medium body and fine tannins. Delicious now.”



### RESERVA 2022 || 94 points

“Very fine, chalky tannins from this warm vintage, showing refinement and freshness. Long, spicy finish. Really solid. Drink or hold.”



### RODA I BLANCO 2022 || 96 points

“Fine spices with a mineral edge to the roasted pineapple, yellow nectarines, pomelo and salted cream. Nice phenolics with full body, fresh yet creamy acidity and a long, textured finish. Viura, garnacha blanca and malvasia. One of the best out there. Drink now.”



### RODA I 2021 || 96 points

“Fresh blackberries provide spicy lift with bay leaves, graphite, iodine and cocoa powder. The wine is fresh and bright on the palate with medium to full body and fine, chalky tannins. Drink upon release in 2026 or hold.”



### CIRSION 2022 || 99 points

“Rich but precise. The wood spices are still present, but the depth of fruit is really impressive. Resolved, powdery tannins lead to a lingering, filigreed finish. Sustained and effortless. A selection of tempranillo with 15% graciano. Already delicious but give it two more years in bottle. Around 3,000 bottles.”
