CORIMBO 2021 || 94 points

“Aroms of plush dark chocolate, fresh blackberries and touches of graphite, roasted red peppers, fine sweet spices and minerals. Juicy and nicely chewy, with a medium to full body and a long finish. Tightly wound tannins, but there is no hint of over-extraction. 100% tempranillo. Drink or hold.”

CORIMBO 2022 || 93 points

“This wine shows aromas of ripe fruit, dark cherries and some grilled herbs. Good-quality tannins. Firm, fine-grained and tight, with a medium to full body and a long, tightly wound finish. A structured Ribera del Duero that’s not overdone. Drink from 2026.”



CORIMBO I 2019 || 95 points

“Aromas of plush roasted spices, cedar, fine hazelnuts, chocolate and deep, fresh blackberries. Full-bodied and juicy, with tight chalky tannins and a very long, fine-boned finish. Structured but dissolved. 100% tempranillo. Drink or hold.”
