BODEGAS RODA



SELA 2023 || 91 points

“This is tightly meshed up front, with sculpted tannins aligned with flavors of creamed cherry, mulberry, mocha, licorice root and sweet tobacco. The profile expands nicely on the palate, supported by midpalate density and a fleshier texture through the finish.”



RESERVA 2021 || 92 points

“Sleek and harmonious, with dark accents of smoke, espresso and bay leaf lacing ripe black currant and black cherry fruit flavors. The sculpted tannins are a well-knit, supple frame, firming the spiced finish. Approachable today but will show nicely with cellaring.”



RODA I 2020 || 91 points

“Fresh, with a streak of balsamico-laced acidity, this fluid red offers flavors of baked black cherry and macerated black raspberry, plus accents of medicinal herbs, dark chocolate mousse and licorice root. A frame of supple tannins emerges to firm the chalky finish.”



CIRSION 2021 || 95 points

“Hints of eucalyptus and anise on the nose accent the palate’s macerated cherry and black raspberry fruit, black olive, mocha and mineral notes. This is rich and finely balanced, integrating mouthwatering acidity and sculpted, muscular tannins. There’s tightly coiled tension despite its good expression, suggesting a long life ahead.”
